Jazz in Progress: The Next Faces of Jazz is a partnership between BMCC Tribeca Performing Arts Center and the DC Jazz Festival. DCJazzPrix, part of DC Jazz Fest, is a global competition created to recognize and support top rising jazz band talent, and is designed to help launch and promote the careers of emerging jazz ensembles.

Julieta Eugenio is an Argentinian Saxophonist based in New York City. Since obtaining her Jazz Masters Degree from Queens College, she has blazed a trail in the industry and worked alongside the finest jazz musicians across the globe. In April 2017, Julieta won the International Women in Jazz competition as a member of the SIJ trio. She has shared the stage & recorded with legends such as Johnny O'Neal, Master Philip Harper, David Kikoski, and Leon Parker. In March 2022, Julieta released her debut album JUMP and the Julieta Eugenia Trio snagged the 1st place prize in the 2022 DCJazzPrix. Additionally, she has been nominated for Best New Artist by the Jazz Music Awards!

Mounting physical structures, motif, and pattern will embody the ways in which we, as humans, are habit forming creatures. The structures will be unpacked over the course of the evening through a playful, athletic, and sensuous movement vocabulary. The ultimate iourney of the work will tell a story of discernment, unpacking how we can be empowered by our habits and not impaired by them. 





